AED at HLC!

Through much effort and leadership over the past few years by our school nurse, Mrs. Debra Cote, and the generous financial support of the Monmouth FRIENDS Team, the Monmouth Athletic Boosters, and the Monmouth PTO, each of our Monmouth schools have received an AED machine. The AED is located on the right-hand wall in the hallway before the gym.

According to the American Heart Association, an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is a computerized medical device that can check a person's heart rhythm, recognize a rhythm that requires a shock, and advise the rescuer when a shock is needed. The AED uses voice prompts, lights and text messages to tell the rescuer the steps to take (www.heart.org). Staff members will be receiving training in the near future. Again, thank you Mrs. Cote for your dedication to the health and well-being of all our community members.
